

A special meeting of the City Council was held on Wednesday, July 31, 2002 at 5:00 p.m. with Mayor John Herman presiding. All council members were present as well as City Clerk Dolly Schultz, Engineer Bill Sayre and reporter Laurie Bonsack.

A motion was made by Carroll, seconded by Gaines and carried to hire two part time individuals at the Wells Library, Sue Rath and Henry Hendricks. They will start at \$8.50/hr and will split the hours normally worked by an assistant librarian.

Engineer Bill Sayre was present at the council's request to discuss water, storm and sanitary improvements on four blocks of West Franklin, from 2nd Ave. SW to 6th Ave. SW. Council would like very much to start the project yet this year, therefore a motion was entertained by Carroll, seconded by Corbin and carried to adopt Resolution 2002-03, authorizing Bolton & Menk to prepare a preliminary report on the feasibility of the improvements and estimated costs involved. Sayre will review the inspection report on the sewers in that area and then meet with the street committee to discuss the possibilities prior to preparing the report.

As no other business could be discussed at this time, the meeting was adjourned.
