Council Member Gaines introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

### **RESOLUTION NO. 2006-09**

#### **A RESOLUTION NULLIFYING A JOB OPPORTUNITY BUILDING ZONE (JOBZ) BUSINESS SUBSIDY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WELLS, MN AND WELLS CO-PACK FOODS, INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the 2003 Minnesota Legislature passed legislation creating Job Opportunity Building Zones (JOBZ); and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Wells affords JOBZ benefits to companies desirous of locating in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, A Job Opportunity Building Zone Business Subsidy Agreement was made on November 10, 2005, by and between the City of Wells, Minnesota, and Wells Co-Pack Foods, Inc. for Wells Subzone 159.

**WHEREAS**, Wells Co-Pack Foods, Inc. has received no financial benefits from the Job Opportunity Building Zone (JOBZ) program; and

**WHEREAS**, , Reiner Eisen, owner of Wells Co-Pack Foods, Inc. has requested that Wells Co-Pack Foods, Inc. be withdrawn from the Job Opportunity Building Zone (JOBZ) program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Wells City Council that the Job Opportunity Building Zone Business Subsidy Agreement made on November 10, 2005, by and between the City of Wells, Minnesota, and Wells Co-Pack Foods, Inc. for Wells JOBZ Subzone 159 is hereby null and void.


The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Council Member Linde and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor:

Jacobson, Carroll, Burns, Linde and Gaines


