Council Member Savick introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-16

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE UNITED SOUTH CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT'S OPERATING LEVY REFERENDUM

WHEREAS, the United South Central (USC) school district will be holding an operating levy referendum election on Tuesday, November 6, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the "cancel and replace" levy will cancel the existing \$642.39 per pupil levy and replace it with a \$1,000 per pupil levy. In essence, USC would gain \$357.61 per pupil per year; and

WHEREAS, the operating levy is needed in order to maintain the high quality of educational programs available at USC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Wells City Council that council publicly supports the November 6th Operating Levy Referendum.


The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Council Member Burns and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor:
