#### A RESOLUTION ISSUING AN ORDER FOR ABATEMENT OF A NUISANCE

The grounds for this Order are:

1. You are the owner of record of the property located at 450 – 9<sup>th</sup> Street SW, Wells, Minnesota.
2. The City of Wells has received complaints about the current condition of the property located at the above-described address concerning the present condition of the premises and its impact on public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO:

1. Abate the nuisances located at 450 – 9<sup>th</sup> Street SW, Wells, Minnesota, by making the following repairs to said structure by March 12, 2008:

All unlicensed vehicles must be currently licensed or removed off premises.

All garbage/junk in yard must be removed.

Old boat must be currently licensed or removed off premises.

All garbage/junk in back of pick up truck must be removed.

2. That a motion for summary enforcement of this order will be made to the Faribault County District Court unless the corrective action required by this order is taken, or unless an answer to this order is filed with the Wells City Attorney, David F. Frundt, Frundt & Johnson, Ltd., 117 W. 5<sup>th</sup> St., PO Box 95, Blue Earth, MN 56013 within twenty (20) days from the date this order is served upon you.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Council Member Burns and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor:


