**A RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS
AND ORDERING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to a resolution passed by the council on March 22, 2010, Wesley W. Brown, Senior Project Manager for Bolton & Menk, Inc. has prepared plans and specifications for the improvement of the following streets/avenues:

Bituminous Overlay

Fourth Avenue SE from Fifth Street SE to Tenth Street SE
Second Avenue SE from Third Street SE to Fourth Street SE
Second Avenue SE from First Street SE to Second Street SE
Third Avenue SW from First Street SW to Franklin Street
Third Avenue NW from First Street NW to Second Street NW
Fourth Avenue SW from First Street SW to Franklin Street
Fourth Avenue SW from Third Street SW to Fifth Street SW

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF WELLS, MINNESOTA:**

1. Such plans and specifications, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby approved.
2. The City Administrator-Treasurer shall prepare and cause to be inserted in the official paper an advertisement for bids upon the making of such improvements under such approved plans and specifications. The advertisement shall be published for 3 weeks, shall specify the work to be done, shall state that bids will be received at City Hall until 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 6, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened in the Conference Room of City Hall by the engineer and City Administrator, will then be tabulated, and will be considered by the council at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 10, 2010, in the Council Chambers at the Community Center, 189 1st Street SE, Wells, MN 56097. Any bidder whose responsibility is questioned during consideration of the bid will be given an opportunity to address the council on the issue of responsibility.

No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed with the City Administrator-Treasurer and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, bid bond or certified check payable to the City Administrator-Treasurer for 5% of the amount of such bid.
