MINUTES

Special Session of City Council City of Wells

The Wells City Council convened in Special session on Tuesday, October 11, 2011 from 2:00 p.m. until 4:45 p.m. in the Wells Community Center, Council Chambers. Mayor Ron Gaines called the meeting to order with the following council members and employees present: Councilmember Steve Burns, Councilmember Jim Durfee, Councilmember Ann Marie Schuster and Councilmember Ashley Seedorf. Employees present: Street Supervisor Janie Whim, City Attorney David Frundt and City Administrator Jeremy Germann. Mayor Gaines led the group in the “Pledge of Allegiance.”

NEW BUSINESS:
