A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECLARING MUNICIPAL PROPERTY SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE WELLS CHIEF OF POLICE TO DISPOSE OF SAID BY PUBLIC SALE

WHEREAS, the City of Wells owns police department equipment which have value being sold for which the city no longer has a planned use. The equipment include, but are not limited to weapons with the following serial numbers:

WHEREAS, the City of Wells, Minnesota is under the understanding that the said property is marketable in its present condition; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wells is desirous of selling this surplus material as it has no planned used for said property in the near future and has not for a time being; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City of Wells does hereby resolve as follows: That said property are owned by the city and are hereby declared to be surplus property of the city; that the chief of police is hereby authorized to offer said materials for sale, either real or electronic, to the highest offer as permitted by state law.
