CITY OF WELLS RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 09

A RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND ORDERING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to a resolution passed by the council on March 12, 2012, Wesley W. Brown, Project Engineer for Bolton & Menk, Inc. has prepared plans and specifications for the improvement of the following streets/avenues:

Bituminous Overlay

Second Avenue Southeast from Fifth Street SE to Seventh Street SE

Bituminous Reconstruction

Fourth Avenue Northwest from Franklin to First Street NW

Aggregate Base & Concrete (New Street)

Ninth Avenue Southwest from Seventh Street SW to Eighth Street SW

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLS, MINNESOTA:

1. Such plans and specifications, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby approved.
2. Bolton & Menk, Inc. shall prepare and cause to be inserted in the official paper an advertisement for bids upon the making of such improvements under such approved plans and specifications. The advertisement shall be published for 3 weeks, shall specify the work to be done, shall state that bids will be received at City Hall until 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 07, 2012, at which time they will be publicly opened in the Conference Room of City Hall by the engineer and City Administrator, will then be tabulated, and will be considered by the council at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 11, 2012, in the Council Chambers at the Community Center, 189 1st Street SE, Wells, MN 56097. Any bidder

whose responsibility is questioned during consideration of the bid will be given an opportunity to address the council on the issue of responsibility.

No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed at City Hall and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, bid bond or certified check payable to the City of Wells for 5% of the amount of such bid.
