CITY OF WELLS RESOLUTION NO. 2014-07

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF WELLS SIDEWALK AND TRAIL PLAN

WHEREAS, the Wells Active Living Coalition (WALC) and Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Committee have been very active in promoting healthy living through walking and biking both recreationally and as an alternate means of transportation in Wells since 2010 when the community received a Statewide Health Improvement Program (SHIP) grant;

AND WHEREAS, the WALC worked with the Minnesota Department of Health on various active living initiatives including SRTS, sidewalks/trails and general walkability;

AND WHEREAS, as part of that that effort, the WALC conducted a public survey in 2012 to identify locations in town that residents desired access by foot or bicycle;

AND WHEREAS, at the same time, the Wells SRTS Committee was also working to identify safe routes for students to walk or bike to the new United South Central (USC) School site.

AND WHEREAS, the purpose of the Plan is to bring together efforts of both the WALC and SRTS committees into one comprehensive plan for the community to consider in moving forward with sidewalk/trail projects;

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wells reviewed and discussed the Plan on March 28, 2014 and April 14, 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLS, MINNESOTA that the City Council of the City of Wells adopted said Plan as the City of Wells Sidewalk and Trail Plan on April 14, 2014.
