### TREE TRIMMING

The City of Wells will be trimming street boulevard trees that hang over curb lines and alleys this fall and throughout the winter to prevent damage to City equipment. If you wish to trim these trees yourself, please contact the **Street Department at 553-5415** and leave a message. Branches should be trimmed so that they do not extend past the street curb line.

### LEAF BURNING

Burning of leaves is permitted between October 1 and December 1 under the following rules:

1. Noon to 8 pm only
2. Adult supervision required
3. No more than 3 feet in height or diameter
4. No closer than 25 feet to any structures
5. No more than one fire per property
6. No burning in streets or alleys
7. Not permitted during state burn bans



It is recommended that a water hose be readily available when burning leaves.

### HYDRANT FLUSHING



The Wells Public Utility will begin flushing water-mains & hydrants the week of September 30th during daytime hours. This will take about five (5) days to complete depending upon the weather.

They will begin in the southwest part of town west of Hwy. 22 and work north. After that side is complete, they will begin on the east side of Hwy. 22 and work north.
