GOLF CART REMINDER:

Golf Cart Permit renewal is required every year. Cost is \$5.00. Proof of insurance is required.

Please note the following rules and regulations:

- Operate on designated routes from sunrise to sunset .
- Avoid operation in inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog or other conditions or when there is insufficient light to clearly see persons and vehicles on the streets/roadways.
- Golf Carts must be equipped with slow moving vehicle emblem.
- The City assumes no liability for any injuries to any persons or property, which may result from operation of a motorized golf cart.

GOLF CARTS ARE NOT PERMITTED:

- (A) MN Hwy 22;
- (B) MN Hwy 109;
- (C) Broadway from 7th Street SW north to 2nd Street NE (mostly CSAH 61);
- (D) Franklin Street from South Broadway to MN 22/2nd Ave NW (CSAH 61);
- (E) 2nd Avenue NW north from MN 109/22 intersection (CSAH 29);
- (F) 2nd Street NW east from MN 22/2nd Ave NW to dead-end (CSAH 62);
- (G) 2nd Avenue NE south from 2nd Street NW to 1st Street NE (CSAH 62);
- (H) 1st Street NE east from 2nd Avenue NE to MN 109 (CSAH 62);
- (I) 1st Street NE east from 109 to City Limit (CSAH 32);
- (J) 3rd Street SW east from 3rd Avenue SW to Broadway then 3rd Street SE east from Broadway to MN 109 (CSAH 60);
- (K) Public alleys except to enter/exit garage/storage shed owned by golf cart owner;
- (L) St. Casimir Cemetery;
- (M) Rosehill Cemetery;
- (N) Half-Moon Park (except for Kernel Days)



PET LICENSES



All cats and dogs over the age of three (3) months shall be licensed. It is imperative all cats and dogs are licensed in the case they are picked up by the City of Wells. If they are licensed, the City can contact the owner immediately instead of impounding the animal with All Pets in Mapleton. If your animal is impounded, there will be a fee to release your animal.

Pet Licenses need to be renewed every two years (current period: January 1, 2013—December 31, 2015). Pet licenses cost \$10.00 for the two year period. If you are obtaining a license during the second year of a two-year period, the price is reduced to \$5.00. If you are keeping more than three (3) unspayed/ unneutered dogs or cats, an additional kennel license and fee is required. A kennel license is \$50.00 per year. No more than 10 dogs or cats are permitted on the same premise.

Licenses can be purchased at Wells City Hall, 125 S Broadway. **Proof of rabies vaccination must be provided for each animal.** For questions, please contact City Hall at (507) 553-6371 or by emailing cityhall@cityofwells.net.

- Garbage- No CHARGE. No construction materials will be permitted.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

County Highway Department Shop (Corner of 3rd Street Se/Hwy 109)

This collection event is open to all residents of Faribault or Martin County and is being held on Saturday, June 20, 2015 from 9 am to noon.

Items accepted at no charge:

Latex or oil based paint, aerosol cans (with product inside), fuels, degreasers, garden products, paint thinner, furniture stripper, roofing tap, household chemicals, poisons, rechargeable batteries and cell phones.

NO Fluorescent Bulbs or Ballasts

- NO empty paint cans— only cans containing liquid paint will be accepted.
- NO ag chemicals or business products will be accepted. Both of these can be brought to the hazardous waste facility in Truman by special appointment. Call (507) 776-3232 to make arrangements.
