Code Enforcement Reminders

GRASS/WEEDS: Please be courteous and mow your grass before it reaches 6 inches in length. If you do not, the City will do it for you and you will be billed. The City advertises this notice every year in the Wells Mirror, Shopper and on Facebook. You will not receive a warning letter.

POOLS: All pools measuring less than four feet from the ground require a fence. Wading pools or "kiddie pools" do not require a fence as long as they are emptied when not in use.

TIRES & STANDING WATER: Help prevent mosquitoes from laying eggs by removing objects that hold water, such as: tires, flowerpot saucers, pool covers, birdbaths, trash cans, and pet water bowls.

Tuesday, August 2nd - Candidate filing for Municipal Elections opens. Filing fee is \$2.00.

Tuesday, August 9th - **State Primary Election Day.** Hours are 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Vote at Community Center.

Tuesday, August 16th - Candidate filing for Municipal Elections closes at 5 pm.

Tuesday, November 8th - **State General Election Day.** Hours at 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Vote at Community Center.

NOTICE TO PARENTS SENDING CHILDREN TO THE WELLS POOL:

The Wells Pool is NOT a daycare center.

The rules are as follows:

"Babysitters" must be at least 12 years old and the children they are watching must be at least 5 years old.

No child under 8 years old may enter the pool without a parent/guardian/adult or a 12 year old babysitter.

If your child needs a life jacket to swim in the big pool, a parent must be present.

The job of the lifeguard is to save lives and teach swimming lessons, not to babysit your children.


