WHEREAS, the City of Wells, Minnesota is under the understanding that the said property is marketable in its present condition by being sold or recycled.

WHEREAS, The City of Wells, Minnesota is desirous of selling this surplus material as it has no planned used for the said property in the near future and has not for some time.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Wells, Minnesota does hereby resolve as follows: That the said materials are owned by the city and are hereby declared to be surplus property of the city; that the city administrator is hereby authorized to offer said materials for sale by public auction, either real or electronic, to the highest bidder or recycled as permitted by state law or dispose of the material if no there are no bidders.
