**A RESOLUTION ORDERING IMPROVEMENT
AND PREPARATION OF PLANS**

WHEREAS, a resolution of the city council adopted the 14th day of May, 2012 fixed a date for a council hearing on the proposed improvements listed below:

Concrete Reconstruction with Faribault County

Second Street Northeast (CSAH 62) from Second Avenue to TH 109

Aggregate Base & Concrete (New Street)

Ninth Avenue Southwest from Seventh Street SW to Eighth Street SW

AND WHEREAS, ten days' mailed notice and two weeks' published notice of the hearing was given, and the hearing was held thereon on the 11th day of June, 2012 at which all persons desiring to be heard were given an opportunity to be heard thereon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLS, MINNESOTA:

1. Such improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible as detailed in the feasibility report.
2. Such improvement is hereby ordered as proposed in the council resolution adopted the 11th day of June, 2012. Revised by Council motion on November 26, 2012.
3. Bolton and Menk is hereby designated as the engineer for this improvement. The engineer shall prepare plans and specifications for the making of such improvement.
4. The city council declares its official intent to reimburse itself for the costs of the improvement from the proceeds of the tax exempt bond.
