A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement for bids for the improvement of the following:

**Wells Municipal Airport Improvement
Apron Resurfacing**

bids were received, opened and tabulated according to law, and the following bids were received complying with the advertisement:

Ulland Brothers	\$58,725.00
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AND WHEREAS, it appears that Ulland Brothers is the lowest responsible bidder for the amount of \$58,725.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLS, MINNESOTA:

1. The Mayor and Deputy Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Ulland Brothers in the name of the City of Wells for the improvement of the Wells Municipal Airport Apron Resurfacing, according to the plans and specifications therefore approved by the City Council and on file in City Hall. Bid prices are expected to apply at the time when the Mn/DOT Grant is actually received for the work. The City of Wells reserves the right to only award an amount of work to be constructed based on the amount of Mn/DOT Funding available at no change in unit price.

2. The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to return forthwith to all bidders the deposits made with their bids, except that the deposits of the successful bidder and the next lowest bidder shall be retained until a contract has been signed.
