## CITY OF WELLS RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND ORDERING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 2014-04 of the city council, adopted February 10, 2014, Travis Winter, Project Engineer for Bolton & Menk, Inc. has prepared plans and specifications for the improvement of the following streets/avenues:

**Aggregate Base & Concrete/Bituminous (New Street)**

Eleventh Street Southwest from Second Avenue to Sixth Avenue Southwest  
Sixth Avenue Southwest from Ninth Street to Eleventh Street Southwest  
State Highway 22 Improvements

**Concrete Extension**

Tenth Avenue Southwest extension south to dead end

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLS,  
MINNESOTA:**

1. Such plans and specifications, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby approved.
2. Bolton & Menk, Inc. shall prepare an advertisement for bids upon making of such improvements under such approved plans and specifications. The advertisement shall be published electronically for three weeks and once in the official paper, it shall specify the work to be done, shall state that bids will be received at City Hall until 11:00 am on Thursday, May 8, 2014, at which time they will be publicly opened in the Conference Room of City Hall by the City Engineer, will then be tabulated, and will be considered by the council at 5:00 pm on Monday, May 12, 2014, in the Community Center Council Chamber, 189 1<sup>st</sup> Street SE, Wells, MN 56097. Any bidder whose responsibility is questioned during consideration of the bid will be given an opportunity to address the council on the issue of responsibility.
3. No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed at City Hall and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, bid bond or certified check payable to the City of Wells for 5% of the amount of such bid.
