Council Member _____ introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-04

A RESOLUTION VACATING ALLEY LOCATED ENTIRELY WITHIN BLOCK SIX OF CLARK W. THOMPSON'S ADDITION

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Wells, Minnesota has decided it is in the best interest of the public to vacate a twenty-foot wide right-of-way (alley) located entirely within Lot 6 of Clark W. Thompson Addition, between Second Avenue SW and Third Avenue SW;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on January 24, 2011 in council chambers after notice was duly published in the official newspaper and posted notice had been given, a reasonable attempt was made to give personal notice to all affected property owners, and all persons interested were given an opportunity to be heard;

WHEREAS, any person, corporation, or city owning or controlling easements contained upon the property vacated, reserves the right to continue maintaining the same or to enter upon such way or portion thereof vacated to maintain, repair, replace, remove or otherwise attend thereto;

WHEREAS, it appears it will be in the best interest of the public to vacate such right-of-way (alley) and at least four-fifths of all members of the city council concur in this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Wells, Minnesota, located in the County of Faribault, that the alley described as the north/south platted right-of-way abutting lots 1-12 of Block 6, Clark W. Thompson's Addition be vacated.
